Tuition fees

A Registration Fee of \$200.00 is required upon application; this Registration Fee is not included in tuition costs and is not refundable but may be considered for reapplication). The tuition fee is \$5,900.00 in 10 instalments (\$590.00 per month) payable to CMTEL. We also accept Visa/MasterCard as a method of payment for the tuition fees. Upon acceptance, candidates will be required to prepare for the first week of January either a series of 10 post dated cheques (10 instalments of \$590.00) or a Visa/MasterCard Authorization to bill each monthly instalment. A fee of \$300.00 for the final exams is required in May 2013. Receipts for Income Tax are issued in December 2012 and June 2013. Cost of books that can be obtained at the Institute is \$85.00. Aims of the Education Course

Our aim is to provide teacher candidates with opportunities and resources to gain the necessary knowledge and practical experience to pursue a career as authentic qualified Montessori teachers. The demand for “Top class” Montessori teachers is continually growing. For the past 8 years, 94 % of our graduates have found employment in the many Montessori schools which sets a beautiful record.

The Montessori Diploma course is designed to:

- Keep Montessori philosophy and respect for the children and their needs central to its purpose;
